UG Course : The candidate eligible for getting admission must pass IInd year P.U.C. or Diploma in Engineering

PG Course : The Admission to the PG Course i.e.M.Com as per university norms.

ADMISSION RULES :

- Students from other Universities or Boards shall be admitted to First Year Degree Course only after producing No Objection Certificate from Rani Channamma University Belagavi.
- Students coming from other Universities must produce Migration Certificate from their concerned University.
- All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval by the University.
- Admission to any course is made for the current academic year only. Admission the next higher class is made in the subsequent academic year based on the academic progress and the conduct of the student during the previous year.
- Incomplete admission forms are likely to be rejected.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- The Applicant has to produce Three Stamp Size Photos at the time of admission.
- The applicant has to produce one zerox copy of marks card along with the original marks card.
- The applicants who belong to SC/ST and categories have to provide zerox copies of the caste and Income certificate
- The applicants claiming fee concession shall have to provide two zerox copies of income and caste certificate along with the original.
- The students are asked to take the admission within the stipulated time prescribed by the University.

Library

The college library is well furnished with several text and reference books, journals and periodicals. There is provision for students to borrow books from the library on production of borrower ticket issued by the library under the UGC and PSL Schemes. Text books will be provided to the SC/ST and deserving students for the whole academic year.

More than 31 thousand volumes are purchased for our library and 30 journals subscribed to our library. Separate reading rooms for boys and girls is made available. Our library is computerized with installation of E-library software and Bar Coding. The library has an advisory committee which monitors the activities of the library.

Reading Room

The college has a well equipped Reading Room. It is kept open from 7-30 am. to 2-30 pm.

The Reading Room gets leading dailies in English, Kannada and Hindi. Many standard journals both of general interest and of special areas are being subscribed.

Books to Meritorious Students

1. In addition to the books issued under PSL scheme, other two books will be issued throughout the year to meritorious selected students both in academic and sports activities.
2. A Book is issued to the students on identity Card for the purpose of reference in the library only.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1) Every student must strictly wear his or identity card in the campus.
- 2) Students must help to keep the college campus clean and tidy.
